Title: Pump Truck Driver / Handyperson

Summary of post

Pump truck drivers/Handyperson are responsible for servicing portable toilets whilst in stock and on hire to customers on assigned route(s) and carry out maintenance and repair tasks to our fleet of portable accommodation.

This position routinely requires physical exertion and entering/exiting the pump truck many times per day. Pump truck drivers/Handyperson are exposed to differing weather conditions and sometimes unpleasant odours and sights. The hours may vary by route and season.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE:

Operate the truck in a safe manner in compliance with all Road Traffic Act regulations and company policies.

Provide services to portable toilet unit(s) on assigned route(s) by pumping, washing, and restocking units to company standards in a timely manner.

Provide minor repairs to units on route and at the yard.

Delivery and removal of portable toilet units to/from customers and/or suppliers.

Maintain and update needed route information in an organised manner and communicate with relevant branch personnel.

Professional and friendly interaction with internal and external customers.

Repair, clean, and prepare portable toilet units for delivery, as required.

Repair, clean and prepare portable offices, secure stores and canteen units for delivery, as required.

Carry out basic carpentry work, lock changes, wall and flooring works, painting and general repair works

Maintain a clean truck and functioning pump unit.

Successful candidates will have:

General knowledge and understanding of how to navigate, as well as a working knowledge of the geography of the Greater Manchester and surrounding areas, roadways and a good sense of direction.

Ability to perform physical requirements of the job (physical exertions, including driving, lifting, pushing, pulling and climbing) plus experience driving a Transit type truck and pulling/manoeuvring/backing up a trailer.

Ability and willingness to work overtime, weekends and holidays, especially during the busy summer season.

Good written and verbal communication skills to be able to communicate effectively and professionally with customers and fellow workers.
